
## Guidelines for Visitors at SEARHC Hospitals



SEARHC's main priority is patient and staff safety. Due to the pandemic, the visitor policy has been modified, allowing inpatients one (1) visitor at a time throughout their stay.



## Patients are allowed one (1) visitor

- Visiting hours are 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily, but may be subject to change.
- The care team may ask visitors to leave based on patient care needs.

Exceptions to the single visitor policy include birthing mothers, quardians of minors and end of life cases.



## **Testing**

• COVID-19 testing is not required for asymptomatic visitors.

## **Observe all COVID-19 Guidelines**

- Check in with the screening table upon entry to the hospital each day.
- All visitors must use Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) such as face masks, and hand sanitizing thoroughly and often.
- Stay in the patient's room. Do not wander the halls or other common spaces.
- Limit visits back and forth from the facility.
